

## Swab the Decks

### Notes:

Best played at a moderate speed of about  $\text{♩} = 108$

When moving into Portsmouth Harbour from Swab the Decks, do not play the low G.

Similarly, when moving from Portsmouth Harbour into Jack's Delight, play a high G as the final note.

If you are unable to play the low G in swab the decks, replace it with a middle G.

Play each tune through twice, then return to Swab the Decks and play it twice.
